This additional revenue, together with funds raised from the restricted competitions, enables us to maintain squad fees at a more modest level and to offer a comprehensive program of junior badminton opportunities. Barbara earns additional thanks for her continuing vital role as our Child Welfare Officer.

We are also enormously indebted to John Stobo who continues to astound us with his talent for producing an up-to-date and informative Newsletter that, once started, has to be read through to the final section.

Our indebtedness also extends to junior clubs, schools and private coaches which we recognize as providing an important lynchpin in keeping your Association together.

This year, an enormous amount of time has been expended to update the Constitution in order to better reflect changes at BADMINTON England and the views of the working party. Much credit must go to Gill Bartlett and Malcolm Fraser for their valuable contribution. I would also like to thank Dave Bartlett who continues to lend his expertise behind the scenes.

Treasurer's Report

We managed to finish the year with a surplus of £1,195 (2012: £1,323). This was slightly greater than anticipated.

HSBA aims to minimise fees that have to be charged. The fee is set to try and end the year with neither a surplus nor a deficit. Although we broadly succeeded in previous years, it can be very difficult to always get this right. Our biggest expense is the cost of hiring courts. This, we have already been informed, will be rising again this year. The coaches (and tournament organisers) are the people who put in the greatest amount of time and effort into HSBA – without them there could be no HSBA. Their commitment extends not only to their, not inconsiderable, time (which they give freely on and off the court) but also to direct, out of pocket expenses (such as travel costs). We have never been in a position to reimburse them fully for these expenses. Any fee rise will be kept to a minimum whilst trying to maintain a break even position.

The committee is always looking for additional grants and sources of income that will enable us to provide better levels of training and contributions towards our costs.

Thanks to the hard work of everyone involved in HSBA (in particular the squad managers) we will continue to be an excellent badminton training body for Hertfordshire children.

The accounts this year were, once again, audited by Mr. Doug Stokoe. I would like to thank him for performing this task efficiently and, as with most people involved in HSBA, for no financial gain.

Thanks are also due to Parents for showing up, helping where possible & generally being very supportive.

U15 Squad Report

At the trials on 7th of June 2012, we selected 28 in the squad. Time and again we had some of the top players from under 13's came and trained with us. Few of our top players were given an opportunity to train with u-17's squad with David Brown. Andrew Baird was badly injured at the start of the season regarding his knee and could not compete and train with the squad. Lia Willis trained with under 17 for the season.

We also kept summer training for those who were going to stay with U15 and to those who were moving up from U13's after Easter.

This season we had moved from previous St Albans High school to Birchwood Leisure Centre with a lovely new floor and cheaper to hire the courts.

Team Challenge:

In November 2012 we played in the regional round at Brandon against Suffolk won 7-0, Bedfordshire won 5-2, Norfolk won 6-1 and lost to Essex 1-6. We came second in the regional and were through to finals.

The finals took place at HSV in Hatfield in March 2013. First round we played Cheshire and lost 1-6, with Sussex we lost 1-6. Notts we lost 2-5 and Bucks we lost 0-7 as we lost all the matches we played grouping of four positioning 9th to 12th.

We had already played Notts and lost in our previous round we did not have to play them, next up we had to play Devon and lost 3-4, Surrey lost 0-7 and the finally we were up against Dorset and were defeated 1-6. The squad player gave their best for the team challenge.

We took overall 12th place in the Team Challenge.

Shires League:

This was a big league group with 39 teams.

Throughout the season we had matches against Bedfordshire- won 12-8. Essex we lost 6-14, Cambridgeshire won 14-6, Middlesex we Drew 10 all, Suffolk we lost 18-2, and finally Bucks we won 11-9. As we had finished 9th on the league table we had go into play off and the match drawn was an away match against Derbyshire which we lost 4-16. We came overall 11th in the league table.

Eastern Region U-14:

This tournament hosted by Hertfordshire by John Stobo.

Took place on 17th March 2013 at HSV. We had matches against five other counties.

We had entered two teams Herts 1 and 2 . Herts 1 took the gold and Herts 2 took the bronze award.

Friendly Matches:

Friendly against Oxfordshire an away match, mostly giving our C and B team squad players chance to compete, that we lost 6- 19.

Eastern Region Single sex:

This tournament took place in Docklands in April 13 only for those who were graded G,H and I and ungraded for Girls and Boys own their own group. We entered two Boys teams and two Girls teams.

Boys A team came 4th, and Boys B team came 3rd place. The Girls A team won the gold and Girls B team came 6th.

HBA Representative's Report

This has been as aver an interesting season with all activities continuing, membership still increasing slightly and clubs continue and still struggle with membership. The county teams have survived in their respective groups, the first team have maintained their place in the top group despite most of our ex international being absent. Once again we benefit from the fruits of HSBA with juniors playing a significant part in the senior county teams.

Sport England have agreed a new 4 year plan with BE and are putting some £18 million into badminton in that time. However all sports have been warned that performance in attracting new players to their sport will dictate if those monies will continue to be granted. So more efforts will be made, with less direct support from BE, by the willing volunteers to attract new players, and win back those that have previously played.

It is also hoped that a new initiative can be started to get badminton played in primary schools. We will be working with HSBA to provide a framework for badminton to give schools a way of spending some of the money that the government is giving to primary schools for sport. Many years ago a badminton league was

started in primary schools and this proved a springboard for HSBA to raise its standard which has been maintained ever since.

Working Party:

As a result of last year's meeting we have met with HSV in an effort to bring all the squad coaching together on a Wednesday evening at that venue, to allow greater flexibility, as well as reducing the number of evenings to clash with Performance centres. We have been told unofficially that this will take place for the winter of 2014. In addition new coaches have been attracted to the squads.
