Coaching at HSV

On Saturday June 11 Natalie Munt and Donna Kellogg, both Olympic competitors in Athens 2004, coached 28 Herts youngsters in two gruelling three-hour sessin at Herts Sports Village. Natalie and Donna took time out from their tournament calendar, which included trips to Singapore, followed by Malaysia and the World Championships in the USA. The event would not have taken place without the support and sponsorship of the University of Herts. Co-ordinated jointly by HSBA and HBA, the two groups were given an insight into the current training methods of the country's elite badminton players.

Swifts Presentation Evening
