Background Colour Key:

Grey	A Proxy Voting form had been received by the secretary prior to the meeting either expressing a preference, or delegating that preference to an attendee at the meeting
Red	Ineligible: - duplicate role on the committee - the constitution specifies that committee members holding more than one role only receive a single vote for their committee positions. They are eligible to additional votes if they also represent clubs/schools. - not affiliated in time for the meeting

Meeting

PK opened the meeting and explained that two candidates were standing - Graham Hall (GH) and Mike Newlove (MN). Although the constitution allows for further nominations at the meeting, none were forthcoming.

Melissa Davey, who had nominated GH, gave a short presentation, explaining that she had known Graham for four years and felt that he had the required skills to be a very successful chair. Graham had also provided an extensive document, previously circulated, to support his nomination.

Dave Bartlett, who had nominated MN, gave a presentation showing badminton participation in Hertfordshire (below), explaining Mike is currently involved at all levels, giving him ideal experience to chair HSBA, as the organisation currently has a responsibility for junior badminton from grass roots through to elite players in Hertfordshire:

- a BE registered and insured coach, he has helped at Swifts for many years
- U14 Squad Team Manager
- Treasurer for several years of Welwyn Hatfield Community Badminton Network who has been active in promoting badminton to all levels with the schools, sports centre sessions and clubs
- Has shown that he is not only aware of the importance of the bottom 3 levels (below) but has shown commitment to actively support them
 driving enjoyment and success for our juniors of all abilities.
- Helped obtain BE grant (Sep18) of £5,448 of which £4000 is for junior badminton particularly in WGC
- Helped with a bid this month for £3000 to Hatfield Community Sports Fund for junior badminton in Hatfield
- Years of experience on HSBA committee.
- A true professional team player able to reconcile differences and move things forward.

The voting slips were then collected from those present. PK inspected the proxy vote forms received and accepted that they were valid votes. PK then counted the total votes and declared the result:

Mike Newlove - 36 votes

Graham Hall – 11 votes

- meaning that Mike was elected as chair for the remainder of the 2017/18 season. As Graham had been unsuccessful, he continues in post as vice-chair and so the second vote was not required.

The official business of the meeting having been concluded, the meeting was then declared closed.

Q & A Session

Following the meeting there was a very interesting Q & A session covering several topics. The main points of discussion were:

- The lack of communication from HSBA to clubs, schools and Community Badminton Networks (CBNs). It was explained that HSBA had
 not had a club rep for several seasons, but that Melissa had taken on that position at the last AGM in June, and was still new in role. It
 was hoped that the vacant role of schools rep would also be filled shortly a volunteer had come forward but a committee meeting was
 needed to discuss the offer.
- Job descriptions for all HSBA roles should be available, so that the members know what to expect of their committee.
- Additional/some support was needed for clubs.
- There were several comments/suggestions made during the session:
 - Examine the Aylesbury league as a possible model for a league in Herts, where matches are held in the same venue on a Sunday morning, and players and matches are graded
 - Arrange badminton open days around the county, using county players
 - o HSBA should not become an organisation that just focusses on elite players
 - Look at ways to communicate best practice within the CBNs
 - Look at the main sources of county players and concentrate more HSBA effort there
 - HSBA should be able to provide a player pathway through the juniors continuing into the seniors. This is an area that we have
 improved but need to develop further, especially extending down the senior county teams to overlap with the juniors better. This
 was lost when we pulled out the senior county 4th team some years ago.
