Team Championship: We invite you to enter a team in this exciting tournament. You may enter more than one team, but please make sure that there are enough adults or experienced team captains to look after the teams.

- Each team will consist of 3, 4, or 5 players (all boys or all girls), any **three** of whom must play in each match.
- Players should be in Year 6 or below.
- Each match will consist of one game of singles and one game of doubles.
- Each game will be played to 15 points.
- Each team will play at least four matches.
- Plastic shuttles will be used for all matches.
- Medals/awards/certificates will be awarded to the top three teams in each of the boys, girls and combined (boys and girls results) competitions.

This is a good introduction to competitive play for young players.
It is a friendly tournament, which we hope will encourage fair play and team spirit.

Primary Schools Tournament Rules

- Each team will consist of 3,4 or 5 boys or girls, **three** of whom must play in each match.
- Players should be in Year 6 or below.
- Each match will consist of two games (one Singles game and one Doubles game).
- Games will be played to **15 points with no setting**.
- Plastic shuttles will be used for all matches.
- The winning team in a match will be the team which gains the greater number of points in the two games taken together. In the event of a draw the team winning the **Doubles** will be taken as the winner
- Different players can, if required, play Singles in different matches
- The winning team in a box will be the team who wins the greatest number of matches.
 - In the event of a two-way tie, the winner of the match between the teams will take the higher position.
 - If there is a three-way tie, the team with the greatest number of points scored will take the higher position.
 - If this still results in a tie, the team with the least number of points against will take the higher position.
 - If this still results in a tie, the decision will be made by the Tournament Referee
- Teams will be put on court from a central point. Teams must be complete when called. Match slips should be complete before going onto court.
- Players must ask permission from the Court Manager before leaving the Court area.
- At the end of each match the match result should be entered on the match slip which must then be taken to the referee's table
- A knock-up of no more than two minutes is allowed before each player's first game only. No knock-up is allowed before subsequent games. (Please toss for service and ends before going on court for each game.)
- The referee's decision is final in all matters.

Combined results

The final positions of teams with both boys and girls entered will be added together to give a combined position - the lowest total will be the combined winner.

eg	Little Heath Girls	1	Little Heath Boys	3	Total = 4
	Norton Girls A	2	Norton Boys A	1	Total = 3
	Ladbrooke Girls A	3	Ladbrooke Boys A	2	Total = 5

Therefore, the combined order would be:

- 1 Norton
- 2 Little Heath
- 3 Ladbrooke
