Team Championship: We invite you to enter a team in this exciting tournament. The tournament is open to schools located within Hertfordshire, and to those that have affiliated to HJBA. You may enter more than one team, but please make sure that there are enough adults or experienced team captains to look after the teams.

- Each team will consist of 3, 4, or 5 players (all boys or all girls), any **three** of whom must play in each match
- Each match will consist of one game of singles and one game of doubles.
- Each game will be played to 11, 15 or 21 points, depending on entry size.
- Each team will play at least four matches
- Trophies, medals or certificates will be awarded to the top three teams in each of the boys, girls and combined (boys and girls results) competitions.

This is a good introduction to competitive play for young players.
It is a friendly tournament, which we hope will encourage fair play and team spirit.

Cost: Team Tournament £23 per team

Coaching: The format is designed to cater for all ages and abilities, but is particularly suitable for newer players and those receiving limited coaching.

We will have several experienced coaches working with the players. The players will be divided into small groups and each group will move round to the coaches to learn a variety of skills. Participants do not have to be part of a team competing in the team tournament.

Cost: Coaching Session £3.50 per player

Primary Schools Tournament Rules

1. Each team will consist of 3,4 or 5 boys or girls, **three** of whom must play in each match
2. Each match will consist of two games (one Singles game and one Doubles game)
3. Games will be played to **11, 15 or 21 points with no setting**, depending on the size of the entry
4. The winning team in a match will be the team which gains the greater number of points in the two games taken together. In the event of a draw the team winning the **Doubles** will be taken as the winner
5. Different players can, if required, play Singles in different matches
6. The winning team in a box will be the team who wins the greatest number of matches.
 - a. In the event of a two-way tie, the winner of the match between the teams will take the higher position.
 - b. If there is a three-way tie, the team with the greatest number of points scored will take the higher position.
 - c. If this still results in a tie, the team with the least number of points against will take the higher position.
 - d. If this still results in a tie, the decision will be made by the Tournament Referee
7. Teams will be put on court from a central point. Teams must be complete when called. Match slips should be complete before going onto court
8. Players must ask permission from the Court Manager before leaving the Court area
9. At the end of each match the match result should be entered on the match slip which must then be taken to the referee's table
10. A knock-up of no more than two minutes is allowed before each player's first game only. No knock-up is allowed before subsequent games. (Please toss for service and ends before going on court for each game.)
11. The referee's decision is final in all matters

Combined results

The final positions of teams with both boys and girls entered will be added together to give a combined position - the lowest total will be the combined winner

eg	Little Heath Girls	1	Little Heath Boys	3	Total = 4
	Norton Girls A	2	Norton Boys A	1	Total = 3
	Ladbrooke Girls A	3	Ladbrooke Boys A	2	Total = 5

Therefore the combined order would be

- 1 Norton
- 2 Little Heath
- 3 Ladbrooke
