Awards for All Projects

In May HSBA were successful with their bid for Awards for All. We asked for £3,600 to organise coaching workshops for county, non-county players and coaches. The money will also be spent on a mentoring programme.

The first of these events, a workshop for county players, was held in July. We were very lucky to have England Mixed Doubles partners Natalie Munt (Herts) and Kristian Roebuck (Derby) spend the day with us at HSV.

Natalie, when her busy international schedule allows, represents Hertfordshire as a member of its first team. Her senior international career started in 2002 - she won the doubles at the Nationals that same year and also the doubles at the US Open. This season she was a finalist at the Swiss Open and won both the doubles and mixed at the Welsh Open

Kristian represents Derbyshire and England. He first represented England in 2004 at the Thomas Cup. In 2006 he won the event and has also won the doubles at the Scottish, Czech and Canadian Open Tournaments

The day at the HSV was very successful with Under 14s taking part in the morning session and the older players in the afternoon. All worked extremely hard and enjoyed the experience. Several coaches attended on the day. It was a chance for them to see our juniors in action and also meet with their fellow coaches. Natalie and Kristian spent their lunch break with the coaches passing on their expertise and answering questions.

A similar workshop for club (non-county) players will be held during October. All details will be sent to junior clubs during the next few weeks. Numbers will be restricted as usual so please get entries in early.

Coaches Workshop

This was held at Amwell School on Sunday 2nd September. We were very fortunate to have Nick Goode run the workshop for us. It was aimed at the Level 1 coaches, but all were welcome. It was a successful day, Nick sharing his coaching experiences with newer coaches. All felt the day to be beneficial and well worth attending.

HSBA Junior Leagues

Geoff Daniels has taken over from Pat Walker as organiser of the Junior Leagues. Letters have been sent out to Junior clubs with regard to the 2007/2008 season.

The structure of the league for the coming season will consist of U12, U15 and U18 boys and girls and U15 medley categories.

Boys and girls teams consist of 4 players with each member playing 2 singles and 2 doubles.

Medley teams consist of 2 boys and 2 girls. They each play one game of singles, one level doubles and 2 games of mixed doubles.

Games will be played to 21 using the new 'rally point' scoring system.

Age is taken as at midnight on 31st August/1st September 2007.

Schools may also enter teams into the leagues

In each division, matches are played at home and away against all other teams. If there are more than 5 entries in any division, that division may be split into smaller groups.

Your affiliation fee to HSBA includes one free league entry. Subsequent team entries are £2 each. Please note that clubs entering the league must be affiliated to Badminton England (this does not apply to schools) and the HSBA affiliation fee does not include affiliation to BE.
